Subject: Covid-19 – 20th March 2020

Dear Member

It has come to my attention that the Governing Body instructions issued on 17th March are not been strictly adhered to and I would like to reiterate the following:

- 1. No gatherings or group clusters are allowed on the practice putting green or 1st tee to conform with social distancing protocols i.e. 2 meters apart. Members should arrive at the Club for their BRS allotted time and depart the Club promptly after play.**
- 2. All Members must register on BRS for contact tracing purposes in advance of playing. If we have an incident of coronavirus, it is very important we can trace who the person was in contact with. No member should be registered as Guest on BRS - all names must be input and if a Member brings a guest from outside they must be registered with Raymond in the Pro shop before play.**
- 3. Scorecards should not be required for casual play. There is multiple handling i.e. recording, signing, checking so I have asked Raymond to restrict and control the issuing of cards.**
- 4. Flagsticks and bunker rakes have been removed. Hole locations will be advised on the phone, option 4 and on a notice at the Clubhouse entrance. Caution should be exercised and handling any equipment should be avoided.**

For those of us Members who have asthmatic and/or other underlying medical conditions, we have to avoid meetings, contacts etc. so the clubs have been put away until this pandemic passes.

Golf is one of the few sports still standing so it is imperative that everyone follows the GUI guidelines and Dept of Health and HSE experts directives.

My ask is that all Members act in a professional and responsible manner at this challenging time so that our Club can stay open unless instructed otherwise by the authorities.
